## **State Parks Letter Pass Rules**

- 1. Letter Passes are checked out for either one (1) week (floral backpacks) or three (3) days (blue backpacks).
- 2. Passes may not be placed on hold and they may not be renewed.
- 3. Failure to return passes on time MAY RESULT IN A BAN FROM USING PASSES AGAIN.
- 4. The letter pass must be with the backpack at all times. Passes are kept in a clear folder to show at the entrance and then should be placed back in the backpack.
- 5. Passes allow any person(s) in a family sized vehicle to enter any state park free of charge. (No commercial sized vehicles, RVs, or camper vans may use the letter passes).
- 6. Patrons may go to any state park in Indiana on any day that the park is open, even holidays. The passes are good for the whole day, but patrons must leave the park at closing hours unless they have made arrangements with the state park for overnight stay. The letter pass does not allow for free camping at the park.
- 7. Patrons must obey all park rules. If you or anyone in your party is the cause of the library losing privileges to the park letter passes, the cardholder who checked out the letter pass will be responsible for the cost of ALL current year letter passes.
- 8. If you are taking a pet with you, please be sure to read through the **Pet Guidelines** from the State Parks' Department.
- 9. All backpacks MUST be returned to the **Adult Services Desk.**
